SUPPLEMENTARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS (KÄRCHER WASH SYSTEMS) Service Contracts – Vehicle Valeting Equipment

STATEMENT – These "Supplementary" Terms and Conditions are in addition to the company's general Terms and Conditions specifically when customers contract the company to carry our service/maintenance work.

GENERAL

- 1.1 Unless otherwise stated or agreed service maintenance contracts are limited to the repair and maintenance of equipment only, in accordance with the contract inclusions and exclusions set out in the contract specifics.
- 1.2 All service contracts are payable in advance and the company reserves the right to charge for any unpaid work should the contract be cancelled.
- 1.3 Cancellation of a contract by either party shall be in writing and subject to 3 months notice unless cancellation by the company is for non payment by the customer of service contract invoices which are due under the terms of the contract.

ALL CONTRACT TYPES

- 2.1 Unless otherwise agreed all contracts do not include consumable items, for a full list of consumable items see Clause 20.0
- 2.2 Unless otherwise agreed all contracts do not include the hire of specialist equipment required to comply with law or statute i.e. access platforms, scaffold etc.
- 2.3 All contracts do not include machine frames and superstructures, accident damage, misuse, operator error, theft and vandalism.
- 2.4 Where work is chargeable all charges are applicable i.e. the following: travel, labour, parts, equipment hire and consumables, charges will be made available before any work is carried out
- 2.5 All contracts will list separately the items of equipment covered under the contract.
- 2.6 The Supplier shall not be liable under any circumstances to the Customer or any third party for any indirect or consequential loss of profit, consequential or other economic loss suffered by the Customer howsoever caused, as a result of any negligence, breach of contract, misrepresentation or otherwise.
- 2.7 Neither party shall be liable for any delay or failure to perform any of its obligations if the delay or failure results from events or circumstances outside its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, strikes, lock outs, accidents, war, fire, breakdown of plant or machinery or shortage or unavailability of raw materials from a natural source of supply, and the party shall be entitled to a reasonable extension of its obligations.

Standard – ADVANCE PLUS, ADVANCE & CLASSIC (predetermined contract specification)

PPW – Pence Per Wash (Customer contract based upon metered usage, usually commercial/car vehicle wash machines)

Customised – Customised contracts (where any of the above do not fit the requirements, usually tendered contracts multiple sites but may be used for one off contracts)
